

TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES
October 4, 2021

Call to Order Town Board Meeting: Chairperson Tom Winker called the Town Board Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Quorum established. Pledge of Allegiance recited. Verification of compliance with WI Open Meetings Law.

In Attendance: Supervisors Bill Janeshek and Tom Bichler, Clerk Ginger Murphy, Zoning Administrator Charlie Parks, Dennis Dimmer, Janice Poss, John Risch, Bob Hubing, David Balling, John Jacoby, and 2 interested person, and Mitch Maersch from the *Ozaukee Press* and Rodney Schroeter from the *Sounder*. Treasurer Dayle Parks not present.

Minutes: Motion Bichler/Janeshek to approve the minutes of the September Town Board meeting; all voted in favor.

Zoning Permits: Charlie Parks reported zoning permits issued in August:
#15 George Bush, 5800 Six Mile Rd – Agricultural storage shed
#16 Victoria Ott, 5175 Upper Lakeview Ridge Rd – New residence

Roads: Not much to note. Ditch mowing to be done in the next few weeks. Box culvert being replaced on Cty Rd D which will take a couple weeks to complete.

Transfer Site: Village of Belgium expressed interested in continuing sharing the electronic recycling event every other year beginning 2022.

Certified Survey Map - Risch: Motion Winker/Janeshek to approve the CSM for John & Linda Risch.

Flagpole Purchase: Tom Winker wishes to purchase a flagpole for town hall. A 30' flagpole was \$1,300 in 2017. Dr. Vali volunteered to control the half-staff situations. Citizen donations will be greatly appreciated. Issue will appear on next month's agenda with actual cost.

Snow Removal Bids: No bids were received by the Clerk's office. Tom Bichler received two bids. One from Lawn Care Services and one from A Touch of Class Remodeling. The bids will be investigated further and appear on the November agenda for decision.

2022 Budget: The Clerk distributed a proposed 2022 budget in the amount of \$688,111 (1.8% increase from 2021). The proposed local tax in the amount of \$467,996 is a 0.9% increase from 2021 and consistent with the state allowable levy. Tom Winker stated BFD wants to purchase a new rescue squad at a cost of \$230,000. The Town's portion of this expense will be approximately \$126,000. \$63,000 will be taken out of the Roads budget money and used for the rescue squad purchase in 2022. BFD also wants to purchase airpacks at a cost of \$66,000. A surplus 2021 budget will cover the cost of the airpacks. Hilly Lane will be reconstructed using asphalt millings during Ozaukee County's reconstruction of Cty Rd D.

Citizen Input: 5121 5131 Country Club Beach Rd. Dan Micha addressed the Board concerning the turn-around at the end of Country Club Beach Rd. Vehicles and particularly delivery trucks do not have the needed room to turn around and end up on his property. He also stated there is a bike trail that enters into the turn-around area, and bikes do not stop creating unsafe conditions. Vehicles cannot see them coming. The road will be investigated.

John Jacoby complained of a 911 call that was dispatched to Sheboygan County. He said the dispatcher was extremely rude. Tom Winker will relay this information to Ozaukee Sherriff to convey to Sheboygan County.

Audit the Bills: Monthly invoices were audited and ordered paid.

Adjourn: The Town Board meeting adjourned at 8:23.
